



TO ALL CLARENDON RESIDENTS

Effective Immediately April 4, 2022

Reminder of the city's procedures in trash, limb, and debris pickup. According to Arkansas Department of Environmental Quality there are laws we must follow for illegal dumping and burning. The following pick-up procedures are:

1. Large items such as washers, dryers and water heaters, etc. will still be picked up at the curb as usual.
2. Smaller items should be put in your dumpsters with your household garbage.
3. Limbs should be placed at the curb and should be no longer than 8 feet with a circumference not over 12 inches so they can be cut up with the chipper. **(No fee for smaller amounts. (Truck load quantities will be charged a fee of \$60 per load. The fee must be paid before being picked up.)**
4. Leaves can be burned on your property but, not in the ditch or beside the road, because it affects water drainage. We cannot burn anything, but the landowner can legally burn on his/her private property.
5. Any person dumping or trespassing at the old dump site will be ticketed and **fined up to \$1,000.00. No exceptions.**
6. Do not dump anything at the city shop. Anyone found putting garbage or any trash in the dumpsters at the Street Department Shop will be ticketed.
7. Chips and compose materials will be available at no cost when we start chipping limbs.
8. **Homeowners and/or renters paying contractors to prune or cut trees will be responsible for the removal of the debris. A charge of \$100 a load will be charged if left. The fee must be paid before being picked up.**

Thank you for your patience and understanding as we reinforce these procedures. We are making considerable efforts for our street department to be more effective and economical in cleaning up the city, we greatly appreciate your cooperation.
